Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this thirtieth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven and of the Independence of the United States the thirty sixth.

Joshua Wilson, Robert Armstrong, Lenox Martin, Jonathan Cox, John Burbridge and Barton Carrico as Justices of the Peace for Allegany County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson the sum of ten Dollars for one quarter half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Burbridge of twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter half pay due the first Instant.
