Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Ann Le Vacher the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nunian Pembrey the sum of seventy five Pounds for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Thomas W. Hall fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to The honorable George E. Mitchell fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the legal Representative of Frederick Green Equine deceased the sum of three hundred Dollars for a quarters salary due the first Instant.
