By the Petition of John King, Henry Dodson and John Dodson it appears that they entered into a Recognizance the first in the penalty of twenty pounds the two last in the penalty of ten pounds each for the appearance of the said John King at Prince Georges County Court at April Term eighteen hundred and ten to answer a presentment for committing an Assault and Battery on the Body of Thomas Ball on the twenty fifth of May eighteen hundred and eight. The Petitioners state that the said John King was attending at the said Court almost every day of the said Term and at the said Term the Petitioner John King attended the trial of the action for Assault and Battery brought by Thomas Ball against him and that being ignorant of the Law did believe that after the rendition of the Judgment on the Verdict given in the said action of Assault and Battery that he had nothing further to answer in said Court and although he did attend said Term as aforesaid he never did know that he was presented nor did he hear himself called except when the trial of the said action of Assault and Battery came on. The Petitioners state that they are poor and that the payment of the said forfeitures would greatly distress them. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit one half of the forfeiture of John King and the whole of the forfeitures of Henry Dodson and John Dodson.
