Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson the sum of twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarters half pay due the first day of August last.

By the Petition of William Downes accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Charles County Court it appears that he entered into two Recognizances with Jesse Edelin his Security in the sum of twenty pounds Current Money each Recognizance at August Term eighteen hundred and nine for his appearance at the said Court at March Term eighteen hundred and ten to answer Presentments for a fault and Battery. The Petitioner states that he had in the fall of the Year eighteen hundred and nine contracted for certain lands on lease in Washington County to which he was obliged to remove for the purpose of providing Bread for ten Children and that he left Charles County on or about the first of January eighteen hundred and ten for Washington County with his family and the little property he had acquired by hard and honest labour. That the said Jesse Edelin had promised the Petitioner to inform him particularly whether it would be indispensably necessary for him to attend at the aforesaid March Term, as the Petitioner wished in case it could have
