Monday September 16th 1811

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable John Stephen James Butcher Reverdy G. Swelton, Thomas W. Hall and George E. Mitchell.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George C. Collins the sum of one hundred and nine Dollars and twenty one cents in full of his expenses and allowance for bringing from the State of Pennsylvania George Lewis a fugitive from Justice as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Anderson sixty seven pounds ten Shillings for nine Months half pay due the first Instant.

James Harrison was appointed Coroner for Talbot County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Edward Markland Esquire who was on the twenty Ninth day of April last appointed Keeper of the Penitentiary House in Baltimore County appeared before the Governor and Council and gave Bond with Perry Spencer and Samuel Stevens Junior his Securities in the penalty of two thousand Dollars for the faithful performance of his duties imposed on himself and deputies by the Act of Assembly entitled "An Act respecting Crimes and Punishments" passed at November Session eighteen hundred and nine.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Lazarus Harrison the sum of sixty Dollars for half pay due the first of August last.
