

Entitled an act to reduce into one the several acts of a Assembly respecting Elections, and to regulate said Elections: passed at November Session eighteen hundred and five, authorize and command you to appoint a day to hold an Election in your County of Kent for a Representative of this State to fill the Vacancy in the House of Representatives of the United States occasioned by the Resignation of the aforesaid John Montgomery Esquire, and the said Election shall be held within sixteen days after the receipt of this Warrant, and you shall serve a copy thereof on each of the Judges in each election District of your County at least three days before the day appointed for holding such Election. Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Seal of the State of Maryland, this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven.

Tuesday September the 17/1811

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable James Butcher, Thomas W. Hall and George E. Mitchell.

Ordered that Mr. Robert Welch of Ben be authorized to proceed to Philadelphia, and receive from Captain Irvine Superintendent of Military Stores for the United States, the twelve hundred Stand of Arms fifty Brace of Horsemen's Pistols, and one hundred Horsemen's Swords purchased from the United States by this State and cause them to be immediately transported to Annapolis.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Robert Welch of Ben the sum of one hundred Dollars towards defraying the expenses of transporting the Arms from Philadelphia to Annapolis to be by him accounted for.

Samuel Gopper was appointed a coroner for Kent County in the room of Nathaniel Miller deceased and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Somervell the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half pay due the first day of August last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green Esquire the sum of forty two Dollars and fifty cents as per account passed.

By the Petition of William Sprucebanks of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County it appears that he was fined by said Court at July Term eighteen hundred and ten in four Cases the sum of six pounds
