

Monday November 24th 1811

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable John Stephen, Reverend G. Huselin, Thomas W. Hall and George E. Mitchell.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Ann LeBarber the sum of fifteen pounds Current Money for one quarters half pay due the first Instant

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Merian Purchey the sum of Seventy five pounds for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable John Stephen the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Rogers Esquire the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler the sum of thirty nine pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the Stadt House due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds Current Money for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Reverend G. Huselin the sum of one hundred pounds for six Months salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Hinder the sum of twenty five Dollars for riding Express as per Account passed

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Lewis the sum of Ninety one Dollars and twenty one and a fourth Cents for a Allowance and expenses for bringing John Armstrong from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania a fugitive from the Justice of this State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Lewis the sum of one hundred Dollars for taking and apprehending John Armstrong agreeably to the Governor's Proclamation of the twenty fourth of November in the Year eighteen hundred and nine.

By the Petition of George Upton accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Prince Georges County it appears that he was fined by the Court of said County at September Term last the sum of ten Dollars for a faulting as beating Zaddock Weston.
