The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable John Stephen Reverdy Ghieslin Thomas W. Hall and George E. Mitchell.

Friday November the 8 1811

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable John Stephen Reverdy Ghieslin Thomas W. Hall and George E. Mitchell.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of thirty five Dollars for one year rent of Gun House as per account passed.  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs. Rebecca Forrest the sum of Ninety Dollars for one quarter half pay due the first Instant.  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson the sum of ten Dollars for one quarter half pay due as above.

By the Petition of John Bennett of Talbot County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by Talbot County the sum of twenty pounds Current Money for not keeping a Bridge at his Mill in Repair. The Petitioner states that when he made a purchase of the property on which the said Bridge was built the Flood Gates of the Mill, were entirely blown up and the Bridges and foresh were very much out of repair. That it took great labour expense and much time to repair such parts of the property that would be absolutely necessary to set the Mill to running and tend to reimburse him for heavy charges. That he omitted making Minor Repairs such as the Bridges from a wish to accommodate the Neighbourhood. That the Bridge never was impassible or very dangerous. They also object to its want of length which existed previous to his having purchased the said property. That at the time the presentment was found against him the Materials necessary for repairing the Bridge were nearly all ready and that the same has since been put in good order and made several feet longer than it was before. Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of twenty pounds.
