

On The second Monday in November and eleventh day of the same Month
in The Year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and eleven The General Assembly
of Maryland agreeably to the Constitution and Form of Government proceeded
to the choice of a Governor when Robert Bowie Esquire was elected.

On The Tuesday following and twelfth day of the same Month the General
Assembly made choice of the following Gentlemen as Council to the Governor
to wit George E. Mitchell, John Stephen James Butcher, Thomas W. Hall and
Reverdy G. Hoeslin Esquires.

Wednesday November The 13th 1811

The Honorable George E. Mitchell, John Stephen Thomas W. Hall and
Reverdy G. Hoeslin appeared in The Council Room, and qualified before Nich-
olas Brewer Esquire one of the Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, by taking
The several Oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and
Laws of this State, and making and subscribing a declaration of their belief
in The Christian Religion. Certificate thereof filed.

Ninian Pinney was re-appointed Clerk of The Council, who qualified
as such before Nicholas Brewer Esquire one of the Aldermen of the City
of Annapolis by taking and subscribing the several Oaths and the declar-
ation prescribed for that purpose, as also by taking the oath of support to the
Government of the United States. Certificate thereof filed.

Mr. Jubb Fowler was re-appointed Messenger of The Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry
Benson The sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half
pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain
Richard Anderson The sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings for
one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert E.
Stone Esquire The sum of forty two Dollars it being The amount paid by
him to Mrs Mary Cracher for the use of a Room obtained for a Court
Martial to be by Benjamin Lancaster as per affidavit filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble
George E. Mitchell The sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a
Member of the Council. Certificate thereof filed.
