Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Messrs George Shaw and Company the sum of one hundred and thirty five Dollars, it being the amount of their account for some sets of Marcy's Edition of the Laws of Maryland purchased in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at the previous Session.

Ordered that Mr. John Shaw be paid by the Treasurer of the Western Shore the sum of sixty four Dollars and nineteen and a half cents as per account passed by the Auditor General.
