

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Washington,
the sum of seven Dollars and twenty nine cents as per account
passed by the Auditor.

By the Petition of David Strong of Allegany County it appears that he
was fined by the Court of the said County at October Term eighteen hundred
and eleven the sum of ten pounds Current Money for retailing goods as
a Retailer upon the testimony of David Hoffman to whom the said David
Strong had sold one United States Spelling Book and one Paper of Scrip.
The Petitioner states that being disabled in his Breast and unable to obtain
a livelihood by labour he has for some time past followed the business of a
Retailer in the State of Virginia where he had a licence. That on his way
from Cumberland to the Western parts of Virginia he stopped at the house
of the said David Hoffman and at his request sold him the said
Articles without any intention of violating the laws of the State.
The Petitioner states that he is poor with a wife and four small child-
ren to support. The Board on consideration of which circumstances
and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do
omit the said fine.
