Tuesday December the 24 1811

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable George E. Mitchell James Butcher and Thomas W. Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Groves Esquire the Sum of fourteen Dollars and fifty Cents for printing done for the State as per account passed.

Thomas Compton Esquire was appointed Notary Public for the State of Maryland to reside at Hagers Town in Washington County and Commission issued accordingly.

The Council resumed the consideration of the Appointment of Justices of the Peace and other Officers directed by the Constitution and Law to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till to Morrow.

Thursday December 26 1811

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable George E. Mitchell John Stephen, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Heselton.

William Fitzhugh Junior was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Washington County and Commission issued to Thomas Compton, Adam Ott, Samuel Ruggold, John Hunter, William Gator, Robert Douglass, Robert Smith, Josiah Price, James McClain, Thomas Kennedy, William S. Compton, George Smith, Jacob Schneckly, Martin Kewin, Philip Meares, John Bowler, James Prather, William Gabby, Robert Hughes, Martin Goltz, Ezra Pfifer, John Blackford, William B. Williams, John Wolgamott, Charles Heselton and William Fitzhugh Junior as Justices of the Peace for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to John Chandler Esquire the Sum of thirty six Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler the Sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to purchase Wood to be by him accounted for.

Samuel Gay Junior, Francis Götter, William Bouldin, Alexander Galt, John Wilson, John Wirth, George Johnson and George Gallispie were appointed Justices of the Peace for said County.
