Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David Hamilton fifteen Dollars and thirty seven Cents as per Account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland one Thousand Dollars to be by him placed to the credit of Perry Benson, George Smith and Benjamin Wilcott the Commissioners appointed by the Legislature at November Session eighteen hundred and ten to repair or rebuild under the direction of the Executive the whole or such parts of the Armoury at Easton in Talbot County as may be necessary for the reception and safe keeping of the public Arms and Military Stores and to be by them accounted for

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain John Cook forty Swords and forty Pistols for the use of the Troop of Cavalry commanded by him.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Daniel Martin forty Swords and forty Pistols for the use of the Troop of Horse commanded by him.
