The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Hon-
orable John Stephen, James Butcher, Thomas W. Hall and Reverend
G. H. S. C. L. L.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs
George and John Barber the sum of twenty eight Dollars and eighty
cents for freight on arms as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr.
Richard B. Watts one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr.
Lazarus Harman sixty Dollars for eighteen Months half pay due
as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain
James Buff twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half
pay due the first day of August eighteen hundred and ten.

John Parish was appointed an Inspector of Lumber for the City and
County of Baltimore and Commission issued accordingly to him.

Ordered that the Executive will take of Mr. John Munroe one
hundred and fifty Cartouch Boxes of the quality of the Pattern fur-
nished at one hundred and sixty one cents each.
