The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable John Stephen James Butcher Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Hiselein
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Horatio G. Munroe the sum of sixty four pounds fifteen Shillings and one penny half penny as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs George Shaw and Co forty Dollars and four cents as per account passed.

The Honorable George C. Mitchell having resigned his seat in Council the Board proceeded thereupon to elect another Member in his place. The Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box and on examination thereof it appeared that James Mabb Esquire had a Majority of Votes. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said James Mabb is duly elected a Member of the Executive Council of the State of Maryland.

John Airquith was appointed Coroner for Baltimore County in the room of Nathaniel Hyrson appointed Keeper of the Penitentiary. Ordered that Commission issue. Commission accordingly issued.

Lambert Clayland was appointed Armourer at Canton in the room of John Coats deceased and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Washington G. Tuck the sum of one hundred and eight Dollars and fifty cents in full for his services and expenses in superintending the transportation of the States Arms from Philadelphia to Annapolis as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable George C. Mitchell the sum of thirty pounds seven Shillings and one penny for salary due as a Member of the Council to the twenty sixth ultimo.
