The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable John Stephen, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy Ghieselin

ordered, that the Report of the Committee of conference on the Bill establishing an Equity Court on the Eastern Shore, the Message from the Senate accompanying the same, and the Bill Entitled an act respecting the Equity jurisdiction of the County Courts, be published once in August and once in September in the Maryland Republican and Maryland Gazette at Annapolis: the American Whig, Sun and Federal Gazette at Baltimore: the Star at Easton: the Republican Gazette at Frederick Town: the Maryland Herald at Hageri Town and the National Intelligencer.

ordered that the Armours at Frederick Town forward to this place without delay one hundred tents for the use of the Detachment of Militia ordered to Annapolis.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Henry S. Hall the sum of ten Dollars and sixty cents for riding Express as per account passed by the Auditor General.
