Saturday August the 1 1812

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable John Stephen Beverly Ghieslin and James Mabb.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Rogers Esquire the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the Senate due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer Esquire the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Minnisi Pinkney the sum of seventy five pounds for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mr Robert Wells of Ben fifteen Dollars for riding Express to the Mayor of Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to John Chandler the sum of one hundred Dollars for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.
