The Board proceeded to elect an associate Judge for the sixth Judicial District
in the room of the honorable Thomas Jones deceased. The Ballots being deposited
in the Ballot Box on examination thereof it appeared that Theoderick Blandry
was elected. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said Theoderick Blandry
is duly elected an associate Judge for the said District and Commission issued to him.

of Blankets for the use of the Soldiers.
