By the Petition of John W. Porter accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Prince Georges County Court it appears that he was fined by the said Court at September Term last the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars for keeping a Billiard Table in the Town of Upper Marlborough between the thirty first of March eighteen hundred and twelve and the fifth of April eighteen hundred and twelve without licence. The Petitioner states that he had kept a Billiard Table for several years past in Montgomery County upon which he chiefly depended for a support for himself and a large family. But finding it was with difficulty he could provide a support for his increasing family there, he moved to Upper Marlborough in the Month of December last, when he obtained a permit to keep a Billiard Table until the next County Court thereafter. The Petitioner states that when it became necessary for him to renew his licence he found himself unable to procure Money for that purpose, and was therefore obliged to delay until five days afterwards, for which delay of five days he has been fined as above.
