Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western there pay to Mr. John Wells, Quarter Master to the Troops under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Jacob Small fifty three Dollars and thirty three Cents out of the Contingent Fund for the purchase of Blankets for the use of the Soldiers.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western there pay to Major James Cathoun twelve Dollars it being for a Drumm furnished Captain Collins Artillery Company as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Register of the Land Office be authorized to cause new steps to be put to the Door leading to his office: the expense of the same to be paid out of the sum appropriated for the repairing of the Stadt House.

Ordered that the Register of Wills be authorized to cause the Porch leading into the late Prerogative Office to be repaired: the expense of the same to be paid out of the sum appropriated for the repairing of the Stadt House.

By the Petition of Negro Abby accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Anne Arundel County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at September Term last the sum of five Dollars for committing an Assault and Battery on the body of Richard Igle heart. The Petitioner states that he was committed to the Jail of the said County on the seventh day of July eighteen hundred and twelve for the said offence and has remained there ever since. That he is about thirty two years of age. extremely poor having been blind from his infancy up to the present time. The Board on consideration of which circumstances do remit the said fine of five dollars.
