Harrison, Samuel Ringgold, Alexander M'Herr, Nicholas Ruxton Moore, Stevenson Archer, Robert Wright and Charles Goldsborough Esquires are duly elected Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Great Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty third day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve: and of the Independence of the United States of America the thirty seventh.

By His Excellency Robert Bowie Esquire Governor of Maryland
A Proclamation

Whereas the General Assembly of Maryland did, by an Act, passed at November Session eighteen hundred and five, Entitled, "An Act to reduce into one the several Acts of a Assembly, respecting Elections, and to regulate said Elections," direct that the Governor and Council after having received the Returns of Elections of the Members to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, should enumerate and ascertain the number of Votes given for each and every person voted for as a Member to Congress aforesaid respectively, and should thereupon declare, by Proclamation, signed by the Governor, the names of the persons duly elected in each respective District: We, in pursuance of the directions of the said act, do by this our Proclamation declare that on the thirtieth day of October
