Tuesday November the 3 1812

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable John Stephen, Thomas W. Hall, Reverdy G. Huselin and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Legal Representative of Captain Robert Denny the sum of seventy five Pounds it being the amount of salary due him as Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Minian Pinkney the sum of seventy five Pounds for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter's half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Rogers fourteen Pounds one shilling and three Pence for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Senate due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. [Name] Ninety Dollars for one quarter's half pay due as above.
