

Two hundred Dollars for freight of Guns and powder for Captains Franklin, Smith and Normans Companies as per account lodged with the Auditor.

By the Petition of Edward Atticks of Kent County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at September Term last the sum of six Pounds Current Money for selling Spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that he has never designedly violated any law of the State and that he incurred the said forfeiture because on application to one of the Judges of the said Court for a licence to retail he had erroneously supposed that the Judge (who was not then in a situation to attend to the business) had authorised him to retail without a licence or at least that he would not suffer for so doing. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of six pounds.

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The honorable John Stephen, Thomas W. Hall and Beverly Ghieselin.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of sixty four Pounds thirteen shillings and Nine Pence as per Account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs. George Shaw and Company the sum of twenty five Dollars and thirty seven and a half cents as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain William Hitchcock twelve Dollars and fifty cents for Waggon hire in transporting the Baggage of his Company of Maryland Militia in the Service of the United States for Blades Tavern in Baltimore County to the City of Baltimore as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Somervell the sum of twenty two pounds less Shillings for one quarter of his pay due the first Instant.
