

Friday November the 6 1812

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable John Stephen, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy Ghieselin.

Ordered that the Armourer at Canton be allowed the sum of three hundred Dollars per Annum and it shall be the duty of the said Armourer for the said Salary to keep the Arms under his care in complete order and fit for service.

Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town be allowed the sum of three hundred Dollars per Annum and it shall be the duty of the said Armourer for the said Salary to keep the Arms under his care in complete order and fit for service.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Lambert Clayland the sum of eighty nine Dollars and sixteen and two thirds Cents for Salary due him as Armourer at Canton the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Nicholas King one hundred and eighty Dollars for Salary due him as Armourer at Frederick Town the first Instant.

The Board received the Return of the Sheriffs Election for Anne Arundel County declaring Solomon Groves and Robert Welch of Ken duly elected. Commission issued accordingly to Solomon Groves as Sheriff of the said County.

The Board received the Return of the Sheriffs Election for Queen Annes County declaring Robert Aldron and Richard Moffitt duly elected. Commission issued accordingly to Robert Aldron as Sheriff of the said County.
