

Tuesday November the 24/1812

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander & Marqueses William Bond Martin and Walter Dorsey.

Norman Calkney was re-appointed Clerk of the Council and immediately qualified as such before Nicholas Brewer Esquire one of the Aldermen of the City of Annapolis by taking repeating and subscribing the several oaths and the declaration prescribed by Law for that purpose, as also by taking an oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

M^r Lubbert was re-appointed Messenger of the Council.
