

Benjamin Allen, Colonel Richard Dorsey, Horatio Aldout, Richard Harwood, of Thomas Jacob Franklin Junior, John Chaw Thomas, and Isaac Dorsey were appointed and commissioned Justices of the Levy Court for Anne Arundel County.

By the Petition of John Johnson of Cecil County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at September last the sum of twenty pounds Current Money for not keeping in repair a Bridge over a Mill Race which crossed the public Road in said County. The Petitioner states that he is extremely poor and has a large family to support by his own exertions and that being unable to pay the fine was committed to the Gaol of Cecil County where he now remains and must continue to remain if the fine is not remitted. That he is old and infirm and not the proprietor of the property across which the Road runs. That shortly after the breach was known to him he repaired the same and the public sustained no damage or detention thereby. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
