

Nicholas Brewer Esquire, one of the Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, by taking repeating and subscribing the several Oaths and the Declaration prescribed for that purpose, as well as the Oath of support to the Government of the United States. Certificate thereof filed.

The Executive having received a Copy of the Resolution of the General Assembly authorizing them to procure Cloathing for the Militia stationed at Annapolis, appointed Mr. John Shaw, Agent for purchasing the same and ordered that the following Articles be procured to wit two hundred and thirty Jackets, two hundred and thirty Shirts, two hundred and thirty pair of Stockings, two hundred and thirty pair of Shoes, and two hundred and thirty Overalls or Trowsers for Privates, twenty seven Short coats, twenty seven Shirts, twenty seven pair of Stockings, twenty seven pair of Shoes and twenty seven Cantations for non commissioned officers.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Samuel Moore, the sum of forty six Dollars and sixty two Cents, it being the amount paid for Repairs to the two Gun Carriages loaned to the Columbian Artillery Company commanded by him as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other Officers of annual Appointment till Monday.

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Maguuder, William H. Ward, William Ross Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

Ordered that the late Armourer at Annapolis, deliver to William Croft appointed Armourer the Arms and so forth belonging to the State and in his possession.
