Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Matthias Hartges the sum of seven Dollars for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs. Irvine and Barnes the sum of forty seven Dollars and twenty five cents for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor General.
