The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Alexander & Magistrates William H. Ward and Walter Dickey.

Isaac Redgrave Caleb Briscoe William Wicks John C. Hyrson and William Shivers were appointed and commissioned Coroners for Kent.

Thomas Davis was appointed Inspector of Lumber for Kent County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that Mr John Shaw purchase six Watch boats for the use of the Militia stationed at Annapolis.

Ordered that Mr Jonathan Waters of the City of Annapolis be employed to make eight hundred bar touch Boxes at the price of one hundred and sixty one cents each.

Order to be drawn in favour of Mr Richard B. Watts for the sum of eighty Dollars and ninety six cents the amount of his account for the use of a Forge - it being made appear to the Executive, that the contract for the Forge and smith at the price charged was made by Colonel Small, under authority from the late Executive.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of annual appointment till to Morrow.
