William Stewart, Nicholas Worthington of Thomas and Henry Coars were appointed Justices of the Levy Court for Anne Arundel County in the room of Benjamin Allen, John Chew Thomas and Horatio Bidout who refused to accept and Commission issued to William Stewart Colonel Richard Dorsey Isaac Dorsey Thomas H. Dorsey Jacob Franklin Sumner Nicholas Worthington of Thomas and Henry Coars as Justices of the Levy Court for said County.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of annual appointment till to Morrow.

Friday December the 18/1812

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William Bond Martin Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison a Certificate being produced signed by the Clerk of the Senate and Clerk of the House of Delegates that Samuel Richardson was elected Register of Wills for Harford County. Ordered that Commission issue to him. Commission issued accordingly.

The Council resumed the consideration of the Appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and Laws to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till to Morrow.

Saturday December the 19/1812

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William Bond Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Nicholas Hensy late Armourer at Frederick Town the Sum of thirteen Dollars for Work done at the Armoury as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Arnold
