

Captain Thomas Cromwell was appointed Coroner for Baltimore County in the room of Thomas Moore, resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis, enquire of Richard B. Watts, whether the two six pounders have been mounted by him, as directed by the former Executive and if the same be not mounted that he take possession of them and cause them to be mounted immediately.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Horatio G. Munroe Esquire one hundred and fourteen Dollars and eighty six Cents as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Merian Pinkney two hundred and seventy eight Dollars and twenty five Cents as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable William Bond Martin the sum of fifty Pounds for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that M<sup>r</sup> Henry Deruiger of Philadelphia be employed to make for the State fifty pair of Pistols for thirteen Dollars and fifty Cents per pair.
