Samuel Hays was appointed a Judge of the Levy Court for Cecil County in the room of Furbey Henderson who declines accepting and Commission issued to Samuel C. Hall Robert Evans John M. Black Abraham D. Mitchell James Scanlan Andrew Crow and Samuel Hays as Justices of the Levy Court of the said County.

Ordered that the Armes at Easton, forward to the Army at Annapolis all Arms now in his possession and which are in want of repair. The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of annual appointment till to Morrow.

Friday March the 5 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander S. Magruder William H. Ward William Bond Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

His Excellency the Governor requested to write to the Secretary at War, and inform him of the defenceless situation of Annapolis, and enquire what Troops will be furnished for the protection of the same.

Ordered that the Armes at Annapolis forward to Captain Levi G. Ford, of Cecil County, forty Pistols for the use of his Company as soon as the same shall be received in the Army. To be directed to Clifton to the care of William H. Ward Esq.
