

Saturday March the 10 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander
B. Maguuder Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison

Littleton Dennis Senior was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for Somerset
County in the room of John Stewart resigned and Commissioners issued to Littleton
Dennis Senior Henry James Carroll and Peter Dashiell as Justices of the
orphans Court for said County

The Board having received information that there exists apprehensions
of an Insurrection of the Blacks at Easton it is ordered that in such an event
the Armourer at Easton, deliver to the order of Colonel Smith or in his
absence to the order of Major Meredith, two hundred and fifty stand of
arms and the ammunition which may be necessary. The arms to be
returned as soon as the danger is over.

ordered that the Armourer at Easton deliver to the order of Major
Meredith, new arms in lieu of those received by the Company at Easton
now commanded by Captain George W. Smith upon the arms now in their
hands being returned. Such of those arms as are unfit for use, to be sent
to Annapolis for repair.

ordered that five hundred Pounds of lead, five hundred six pound
ball and one ton of Grape shot and half a Box of Tin be procured by
The Armourer at Annapolis.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis cause one hundred
stand of the new arms to be proved.

The Board having received information from John A. Donaldson
that he cannot manufacture Swords upon the terms offered him.

ordered that Henry Deeringer be employed to make one hundred
Swords at nine Dollars each.

Upon application of Richard B. Watts Jeremiah Hughes and
William Alexander Commissioners for the City of Annapolis perm-
ission given to them, to erect an Engine House, on the public Ground.
The same to be removed, whenever the public require it.
