By the Petition of William Scott of Kent County it appears that he together with a certain James Greenwood entered into a Recognizance in the sum of Ten Pounds for the personal appearance of the said James Greenwood at Kent County Court at September Term last to answer to a charge of an Assault and Battery alledged to have been committed by him on a certain Edward Newcomb. That the said James Greenwood failed to make his personal appearance pursuant to the tenor of the said Recognizance whereby the same became forfeited. The Petitioner states that the offence was trivial in its aspect and in its consequences. That no injury was sustained by the party on whom the offence was committed and but little if any by the violation of the Peace. That the said Greenwood has absconded from the State. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said William Scott from the said Recognizance.

Ordered that the Muskets and Bayonets amounting to five hundred and fifty now in the possession of Major Keall at Fort M^cHenry to be received by this State, from the United States, be delivered to the order of Major General Samuel Smith, who will distribute them in such manner as he may think proper, taking the Bonds of the officers of the Companies
