Monday March the 29. 1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William Bond Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

The Board having received a Memorial from a Committee appointed by the Inhabitants of Easton, to represent the exposed and defenceless situation of that town ordered that the Armourer at Easton, deliver to the order of Brigadier General Benson, Colonel Smith or Major Meredith, two hundred and fifty Stand of Arms and the ammunition which may be necessary. This order to supersede the order which passed on the twentieth Instant.

ordered that one thousand Ball Cartudges be forwarded by the Armourer at Annapolis to Captain William Mackey of Cambridge.

The Governor is requested to forward to the Secretary at War, a copy of the Memorial, to the Executive of Maryland this day submitted from Easton.

M^r Jonathan Waters of Annapolis appointed to make two hundred Memorials at one Dollar and twenty five Cents each.

ordered that in the receipt of the Council his Excellency or any Member of the Board in Annapolis be authorized to order Ammunition to be sent to any part of the State which may be found in want of it.
