Ordered that the armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Ambrose White of Worcester County fifty Pistols for the use of the Troop of Horse commanded by him, and one Box of Cartridges.

Ordered that the armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Jacob Franklin fifteen Muskets and the like number of Cartouch Boxes for the use of the Company commanded by him.

Ordered that the armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Wm S. Tizzard thirty Muskets and the like number of Cartouch Boxes for the use of the Company commanded by him.
