

ordered that the armourer at Annapolis forward to Cambridge one Barrel of Powder, and fifty Cartouch Boxes also twenty five Cannon Ball in addition to those before ordered.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Luyren thirty five Dollars and sixty two Cents for going Express to Brigadier General Forman with General orders.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis be directed to purchase one Thousand pounds of Powder and half of a Box of Tea.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r William Ross Armourer at Annapolis one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Upon application of John Randall Collector of Annapolis ordered that six Muskets and one hundred Cartouches be furnished for the use of a Look out Boat.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ensign George Macwilliams fifteen Dollars to defray his Expenses for carrying Express with a Letter from Colonel Henry Ashton of Saint Marys County.

ordered that Captain Clarke deliver to William Ross Armourer at Annapolis two Barrels of Gun Powder borrowed of the State some time ago.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Clarke half of a Ton of Cannon Shot to be returned to the State when wanted.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Simon Wickes fifty Muskets, the like number of Cartouch Boxes, four hundred Cartouches and three hundred flints for the use of the Company commanded by him.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis forward to Colonel Philip Reed of Kent County one hundred and thirty Muskets, the like number of Cartouch Boxes one Barrel of Powder, two hundred pounds of Lead and five hundred flints for the use of the Militia of Kent County.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Major William B. Beanes two hundred Muskets, the like number of Cartouch Boxes one thousand round of Cartouches and six hundred flints for the use of the Militia of Prince Georges County.

ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town send immediately five hundred Stand of Arms fit for use, to the care of M^r Donald and Ridgely.

ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Richard M^r C. order as many Stand of Arms as he is able to furnish.
