Ordered that the Armours of the Eastern Shore deliver to the bearer for Colonel John Jones of Dorchester County three hundred stand of arms the like number of Cartouch Boxes, six hundred flints, two thousand five hundred Cartridges for the use of the Militia of Dorchester County.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis deliver to Henry Gafaway one Musket, one Cartouch Box, twelve Cartridges and six Flints.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis transmit to the Armours at Easton two Barrels of Powder, three hundred pounds of lead and a small Barrel of flints.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r James Hunter twenty Dollars for riding Expres to Brigadier General Barrick with General orders.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Joseph Sands one hundred muskets the like number of Cartouch Boxes

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry S. Hall ten Dollars for riding Expres to Colonel Gafaway Watkins as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Jonathan Pinkney sixty Muskets and the like number of C. Boxes.
