

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis be directed to furnish cartridges and so forth agreeably to the orders of Lieutenant William Green.

Friday April the 16/1812.

The Council met. Present the Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Thomas Conroy of Harford County sixty four Stand of Arms and the like number of Cartridge Boxes.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain William Norman forty Stand of Arms the like number of Cartridge Boxes, flints and eight hundred cartridges.

x ordered that Lieutenant Waters, be employed to guard the Records stationed at the Vineyard, and that he have authority to employ six persons from the neighbourhood. The Guard to be furnished with ten Muskets and with necessary provision by Mr. Hopkins.

Robert Franklin appointed to procure supplies for the Militia over South River Joseph Gough appointed to procure supplies for the Militia in Saint Marys.

ordered that five hundred Stand of Arms five hundred Cartridge Boxes ten thousand bullets, Cartridge Paper sixty Cannon Balls fifty Cannister shot two thousand five hundred flints be sent to Colonel Henry Ashton of Saint Marys County.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Benjamin McCreery fifty Stand of Arms the like number of Cartridge Boxes six hundred cartridges and one hundred and fifty flints.

ordered that Henry Hall Harwood Esquire Quarter Master deliver to Lieutenant William Saunders one Barrel of Flour and one Barrel of Pork for the use of the Troops at South River commanded by Walters, Saunders and Davis.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis forward to Colonel Theodore Hodgkin two hundred Stand of Arms two hundred Cartridge Boxes two thousand five hundred cartridges and eight hundred flints for the use of the Militia in Calvert County.
