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Monday April the 19/1813

The Council met. Present The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Thomas T. Simmons and William S. Tolland seven hundred Ball cartridges.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Jacob Franklin two Tents for the use of his Company.

Ordered that the Contractors of Annapolis deliver to M<sup>r</sup> John Watkins two Barrels of Flour, one Barrel of Whisky and two hundred weight of Bacon for the use of Captain Franklin's Company.

\* Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M<sup>r</sup> Isaac Hopkins fifty Dollars on account of House room Guard and for forth for the Records.

To Solomon Lowe is appointed contractor, for the Militia of Talbot County.

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Tuesday April the 20/1813

The Council met. Present The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M<sup>r</sup> Peter Berry the sum of thirty six Dollars on account of Waggon for moving Records and Powder and for payment of Ferringes.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to General Cadwallader one hundred and fifty Ball cartridges and one hundred and fifty
