as per account passed by the Auditor General.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Peter Berry  
eight Dollars on account of Waggons for removing Records.

ordered that the Quarter Master furnish foraging Bags for the  
Cavalry now stationed at the seat of Government.

ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Lieutenant  
William Scudder Thirty three Muskets for the use of the Cavalry
