James Duke Innkeeper of Calvert County, appointed contractor for supplies, to be furnished the Militia of that County in case of invasion.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r. Nathan Munroe forty two Dollars on account of Waggon's for removing Records as per account passed by the Auditor General.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r. Charles Chaney twenty four Dollars, on account of Waggon's for removing Records as per account passed by the Auditor General.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Peter Berry eight Dollars on account of Waggon's for removing Records.

ordered that the Quarter Master furnish foraging Bags for the Cavalry now stationed at the Seat of Government.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Lieutenant William Saunders thirty three Muskets for the use of the Company
