Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Robert Franklin two Tents and two Camp Kettles for the use of the Guard stationed at Deep creek.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Monday April the 26th 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Alexander C. Magruder William H. Ward and Thomas G. Addison.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Humphrey one hundred Cartidges for the use of his company.

Ordered that two hundred and thirty six Muskets of those to be sent from Frederick to Baltimore be sent for the use of Harford County to be placed under the care of Colonel William Smith.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis forward to Colonel William Smith of Harford County two hundred and thirty six Cartouch Boxes six hundred flints seventy five pounds of Powder one hundred and fifty weight of Lead, one Box of Pistol Cartidges, one Keg of Cannon Powder and twelve Balls for six Pounders for the use of the Militia of said County.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis send to Mr. William Conway of Baltimore four hundred and fourteen Cartouch Boxes.

Ordered that there be purchased in Baltimore five hundred pounds of Musket Powder, two thousand pounds of Lead and one Box of Tin.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. George Mettelle seventy five Dollars for the hire of his Waggon from April the sixteenth to the twenty seventh Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. James Teopini seventy five Dollars for the hire of his Waggon from the sixteenth of April to the twenty seventh Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Theodore Sadler
