Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Richard Parkers the sum of twenty Dollars for attending on Ammunition Waggon as a Guard to Charles County as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Thomas Woodfield the sum of twenty Dollars for attending on Ammunition as a Guard to Charles County as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Benjamin Lusby the sum of thirty Dollars for going to Port Tobacco as Express as per Account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Thomas G. Addison thirty five Dollars and fifty cents paid by him for expence of expresse to Militia officers as per Account of Major Kearney.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Isaac Nichols fifty four Dollars for the hire of a Waggon engaged in transporting the draughted Militia from Montgomery County as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Isaiah Nichols six Dollars and thirty three cents for rations furnished by William Dawson to the draughted Militia of Montgomery County as per Account passed by the Auditor General.
