Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Isaac Nicholls thirty three Dollars and eighty two cents for rations furnished by John L. Atwood to the draughted Militia of Montgomery County as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Philip Blanton ten Dollars for riding Express with orders to the Militia as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r John Rigby the sum of five Dollars for riding Express with orders to the Militia as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Tiding the sum of ten Dollars for riding Express with orders to the Militia as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Sullivan seven dollars and fifty cents for riding Express with orders to Gen^l Williams as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David Hanson fifty dollars and fifty cents for riding Express with orders to Colonel Lenthicum and others as per account passed by the Auditor General.
