Thursday April the 29/1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander B. Magruder, William H. Ward and Walter Dorsey.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs John and George Barber the sum of twenty seven Dollars paid by them for one coil of Match Rope, for the use of the State.

ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis furnish M<sup>r</sup> Jeremiah Hughes with thirty Muskets for the use of the Guard at Annapolis.

Friday April the 30/1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander B. Magruder, William H. Ward and Thomas G. Addison.

Nasir Bowling appointed Commissary to the Detachment of Militia from Prince Georges County, now stationed at Annapolis.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles C. Chaney one hundred and seven Dollars and fifty cents for the hire of a Waggon employed in transporting arms and ammunition.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs George and John Barber two hundred Dollars for eight Kegs of Powder furnished to the Armourer

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Baldwin the sum of seventeen Dollars and sixty three and a third cents for the hire of a Waggon as per account passed by the Auditor General.
