

Provisions furnished American Prisoners landed from the British Squadron, no provision having been made by the General Government for their subsistence.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Walter Dorsey the sum of three teen hundred and sixty dollars and six cents the amount of William Conway's Bill against the State for Lead Ball and Sallets as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Thomas Brown the sum of seventy Dollars for expre's riding as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Gray twenty Dollars and twenty five cents for expre's riding as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Jonathan Waters the sum of two hundred and six Dollars and eighty two cents for Cartouch Boxes as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r William Ross the sum of one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Wallace thirty eight Dollars and ninety eight cents advanced by him for expences of transporting Troops from Montgomery County to this place as per Account passed.

Ordered that M^r William Conway of Baltimore be directed to purchase six thousand flints for the use of the draughted Militia to be stationed at Baltimore.

Tuesday May the 4. 1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander B. Magruder, Walter Dorsey and Thomas G. Addison

Ordered that Louis Stevenson and John Murray Securities of Thomas Bailey be binding until the first day of January eighteen hundred and fourteen on paying six per cent Interest and costs of Suit.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Francis Edelen the sum of two Dollars and fifteen and a half cents for his expences in attending fifty Militia Men from Piscataway to Annapolis to join Major Hall's Battalion as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that M^r William Ross be directed to pay to the Treasurer of the Western Shore the sum of one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.
