Monday May the 31/1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, William Bond Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

ordered that the Act entitled a further Supplement to the Act entitled an Act for regulating the mode of staying executions, and repealing the acts of Assembly therein mentioned, and for other purposes "be published three times in the Maryland Gazette, the Peoples Monitor, German Paper at Frederick Town, Browns paper at Hagers town, the Federal Republican, Federal Gazette and Baltimore Patriot.

ordered that the Resolution directing notice to be given of all applications for private Acts and Bills for laying out new Roads be published three times in all the newspapers printed in the State, the Federal Republican and National Intelligencer.

Benjamin Henry was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Talbot County and a new Commission issued to the said County including him.

Jonathan Norris was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Frederick County and a new Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out John Cook resigned.

Thomas J. H. Eccleston was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Dorchester County in the room of Thomas Barnett resigned and Commission issued to John Williams, John Krahawn, George Lake, Thomas Ernalls Senior, Thomas Pitt. Moses W. Nesbitt Senior and Thomas J. H. Eccleston as Justices of the Levy Court for said County.

Thomas Fletchall and Lyde Griffith were appointed Justices of the Levy Court for Montgomery County vice Edward Burgess and Henry Jones resigned and Commission issued to Henry C. Gaither, Richard Beall, William Darne Jun. Thomas Gettings, Richard West, Thomas Fletchall and Lyde Griffith as Justices of the Levy Court for said County.
