Tuesday June the 15 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Alexander G. Magruder William H. Ward and Thomas G. Addison.

Samuel P. Richardson was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Frederick County and a new Commission issued to the said County including him.

By the Petition of Genas Hughes of Harford County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at March Term last the sum of six pounds for keeping ordinary without licence. The Petitioner states that he attended at August Term eighteenth hundred and twelve to take out a licence to keep ordinary and that on his applying to the Clerk for a licence he was informed by him that the Court had set apart a certain day for granting licences viz the first Saturday in the Term. The Petitioner states that from a special circumstance he was prevented from attending Court on that day and that the Court adjourned before he had an opportunity to take out licence and that he was ignorant that a Judge of the Orphans Court possessed the power in the recess of the County Court to grant licenses
