Ordered that forty Swords in addition to the forty Pistols heretofore directed be sent to Captain Fords Troop of Horse in Cecil County. to be directed to the honorable William. H. Ward Elkton Cecil County.

Ordered that twenty five Pistols and twenty five Swords be sent to Captain Gaurins Troop of Horse in Saint Marys County. The like number of each to be sent to Captain Forrests Troop of Cavalry upon the Bond required by Act of Assembly being filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Merion Pinkney eighty four Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs George and John Barber one thousand Dollars on Account and to be by them accounted for
